FLOWER ANATOMY

Level – any

Subject – Clil – biology

Aids: tulips, tweezers, magnifying glass

Instructions:

- Examine the tulip flower thoroughly. Determine the sexuality, symmetry of the flower and the position of the ovary.
- Proceed systematically from the perimeter of the flower to the center, remove the individual flower parts with tweezers, record their number and location, and note whether they are loose or fused together.
- Draw a flower diagram, place the flower parts on five concentric circles.
- Under the magnifying glass, look closely at one stamen, draw it and describe its parts.
- Use a magnifying glass to look at the pistil, draw and describe its parts.
